LOCATION

You will find the Economy Museum inside the Federal Reserve Bank of St. Louis at the corner of Broadway and Locust Street in downtown St. Louis. Walk-in visitors should enter through the main entrance on the St. Louis Fed’s pedestrian plaza between Broadway and Fourth Street. **Scheduled groups with over 20 visitors should use the St. Charles Street group entrance.**


